Advisory to Enhanced School Security

As part of the school's continual efforts to enhance security, as well as safety for our pupils, the following measures will be implemented with immediate effect:

- Demonstrated a high sense of responsibility and qualities associated with resilience

Nomination forms can be obtained from your child's/ward's form teacher. The deadline for submission of nominations is **Wednesday, 15 August 2018**. Your child/ward may pass the duly completed form to his/her form teacher.

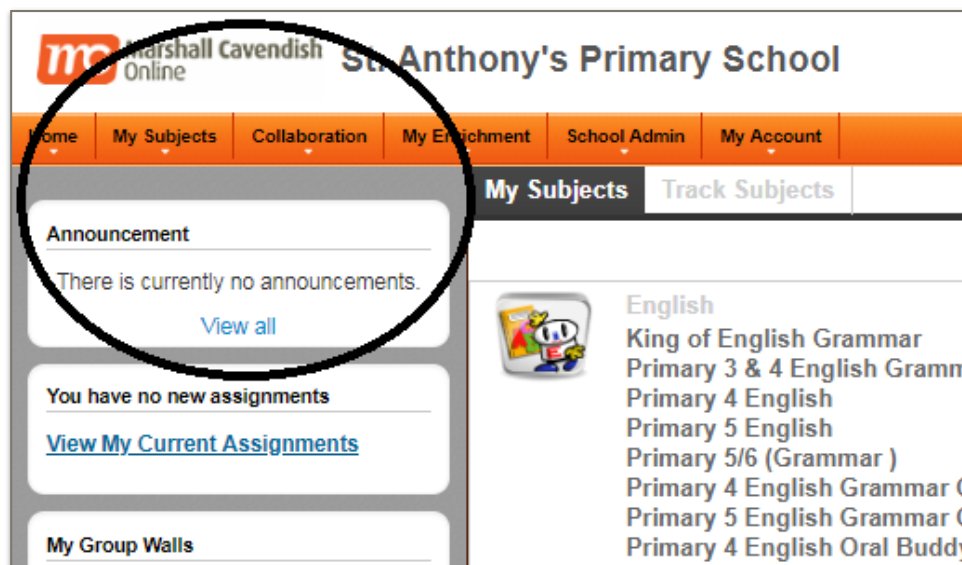
