### **Cy-Bites! (Revealing Information)**

Research has shown that many people who use the internet reveal too much information about themselves, sometimes unknowingly. Interestingly, many internet users feel that other users share too much information online. This is especially so for children, who think they are internet-savvy, and thus become complacent about the dangers online.

Parents can help their children to be safe internet users by observing four simple tips in making sure that:

1. children's social media privacy settings are updated;
2. their locations are not shared;
3. children are not taking part in unknown questionnaires, free giveaways or contests from unreliable sources; and
4. children learn to check the source of the questionnaires, free giveaways or contests, and seek help from trusted adults when in doubt.

To complement the Cyber Wellness curriculum in schools, parents can set a good example at home in the use of technology and play an active role in guiding their children to ensure their safety in the Internet world through the following steps:

Participate in the signing up of social media tools with them.

Activate parental controls in all computing devices.

Role-model good digital habits.

Establish the ground rules for Internet use.

Navigate the Internet with your child to understand his/her use.

Talk to your child about his/her Internet usage and safety.
