Ways To Recycle E-Waste

With the increase in demand for electronic gadgets and the constant desire to stay relevant, it is common that electronic gadgets are replaced frequently, leading to high E-waste. E-waste contains toxic substances and its improper disposal can lead to serious pollution and health problems. Instead of throwing electronic items into the rubbish chute, a safer and more eco-friendly alternative is to recycle them in approved recycling bins.

Our school would like to encourage parents and pupils to play their part to save the environment by dropping off their electronic waste at the RENEW (REcycling the Nation's Electronic Waste) bin, located at our school drop off point from **10 September 2018 onwards**. You can recycle almost any electronic product in the RENEW (REcycling the Nation's Electronic Waste) bin as stated in the table below:

Items that can be recycled:

mobile phones, MP3 player, modems, laptops, wires, remote control, cables and electronic toys

However, all recycled items must be able to fit through the bin's 470mm X 120mm slot. As e-waste is a growing problem worldwide, let's do our part to save the environment by disposing all used e-waste into the RENEW bin (REcycling the Nation's Electronic Waste) bins.
